

Rules for Exhibitors

Installation of your exhibition is done when the gallery is closed. This means you can concentrate on setting up a great display, and take time to move things around. Don't be afraid to ask the Gallery Committee to assist you. They have done this lots of time before, and can offer good advice when needed.

- Provide a list of all artwork, titles, prices, and descriptions of your media.
- Present your work in a professional looking manner—wired or strung for installation, and sale ready.
- The Society has the right to reject any work that due to its content, subject matter, size, shape or weight is a safety hazard, too fragile or unstable to be installed or inappropriate for display. This is a Gallery Committee decision.

Remember to ...

- Return the Gallery to the same condition as it was at the beginning of the exhibition, ordinary wear and tear excepted. Should there be any damage, it is your responsibility and cost to put it right.
- Take full responsibility for your artwork, legal or otherwise. The Society does not carry insurance for your items while on-site.
- Display an "Artist's Statement" to help viewers understand you and your work
- Take time to be on-site during your exhibition. People love to talk to the artist.

Please don't ...

- Use adhesives, staples, tape or foam mounting squares into the wall. No painting, drilling, marking or defacing the gallery or equipment.
- Infringe on the rights of any other party with regard to copyright and originality of the work being displayed.

What We Do For You

Congratulations on being chosen to exhibit in the Paeroa Society of Arts Gallery

- We provide wall space, plinths, pegboards for your display
- A hand-written signboard is set up outside the Gallery each time it is open with your exhibition details
- Flyers showcasing your exhibition are printed and located in the Gallery and key places around town
- Social media promotes your exhibition on Facebook, in Hauraki Herald's What's Up feature and on our website
- Payment of sales less commission of 20% for members and 25% for non-members, is made to you by cheque on or before the 20th of the month following the closing of your exhibition.
- We encourage you to promote your exhibition personally. Please note the Gallery hours and days on your advertising. This is at your cost.
