Paeroa Society of Arts – Gallery Rules

1. ALL work that is offered for sale must be presented in a professional manner, and approved by the Gallery Committee prior to display. The Society reserves the right to decline to display any work submitted.
2. Individual items must carry the name of the artist and the sale price. In the case of paintings, please add a tag on the hanging cord at the back. A commission of 20% is payable to the Paeroa Society of Arts on all sales.
3. Paintings must be framed, to a professional standard, ready to hang, with the correct backing tape properly applied. The edges of unframed canvasses must also be finished to a professional standard. Mounted, unframed painting may also be accepted if suitably packaged.
4. A list must be supplied:
 - a. Name and address and phone numbers, email of the artist, the title of the work/s; medium of work
 - b. Sale Price – to be in round dollars.
5. **INSURANCE:** Insurance rests with the member. All care will be taken of goods in the Paeroa Society of Arts Gallery, but no responsibility will be taken for goods damaged or for theft.
6. Payment for goods sold will be made at the beginning of the month following that in which the sale occurred.
7. To display work for sale in the Gallery, the Artist must be, and remain, a current FULL member of the Society. If membership lapses, the Society reserves the right to remove the Artist's work and, if a current contact is known, advise them accordingly. Three months following that notification uncollected work may become the property of the Society. The Society reserves the right to dispose of any such property as it deems appropriate. The member will be advised that this will happen if their contact details are known (email, phone or address).
8. Work of financial members is usually displayed for sale for a period of six months. When removed from the Gallery, the Artist will be advised by email or phone and asked to collect the work. Three months following that notification, uncollected work may become the property of the Society. The Society reserves the right to dispose of any such property as it deems appropriate and the proceeds will be donated back to the Society.
9. Artists with work for sale in the Gallery are asked to undertake Gallery duty whenever possible.
